When Nebuchadnezzar had a very frightening dream, Daniel, a Jewish member of his court, was called in to interpret it. In his interpretation, Daniel told the king that he would be driven away from people and live with the wild animals for seven years until he acknowledged that the Most High was sovereign over the kingdom of men. He warned the king to renounce his sins. Nebuchadnezzar refused. He made a huge statue of himself, which he ordered everyone to worship. When his Jewish servants refused to do so, he had them thrown into a fiery furnace, from which the Lord rescued them. Nebuchadnezzar still did not follow Daniel's advice and everything happened just as Daniel said it would. The Scripture: Daniel 4:34-36 "At the end of that time, I, Nebuchadnezzar, raised my eyes toward heaven, and my sanity was restored. Then I praised the Most High; I honored and glorified him who lives forever... At the same time my sanity was restored, my honor and splendor was returned to me for the glory of my kingdom." 32.
